

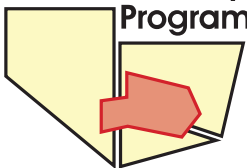
These fruits cannot be transported into the Pest Free Area (PFA), Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone (FFEZ) or across State borders unless they are accompanied by certification or a permit.

Host fruit or vegetables without a certificate or permit must be disposed of in the quarantine bins located on the roadside before entering a FFEZ, PFA or crossing a State border.



**WARNING:** A maximum penalty in the order of \$100,000 may apply if host fruit or vegetables are taken into a PFA, FFEZ or across a State border without certification or a permit.
